In November, 2013, the world lost an incredible 16 year old beautiful soul, when Olivia Wise passed away. In early 2012, Olivia and her family's worlds were turned upside down in a heartbeat. After suffering a series of severe seizures, Olivia was diagnosed with a very rare form of an inoperable brain tumour.

Olivia's confidence, courage, love & lyrics gained world-wide attention when her heartwarming, inspiring rendition of Katy Perry's hit song 'Roar' went viral on YouTube (over 3.7 million hits to date). Olivia remarkably gathered the strength to make it to a recording studio two months prior to her untimely passing. Your sponsorship dollars, through The LivWise Foundation, will continue funding the special research study of BMMRD glioblastoma brain tumours under the direction of Dr. Uri Tabori, Dr. Eric Bouffet and Dr. Cynthia Hawkins and their research team at The Hospital for Sick Children as they have made incredible strides with positive responses to immunotherapy treatment in Canadian children with brain cancer.

Support this year, will enable researchers to expand their initial findings to other children with glioblastoma by investigating the immune profile of these tumours and correlating this with response to therapy to predict who will best respond to these immunotherapy treatments.

To date, the LivWise Foundation has contributed approximately \$300,000 between this project, PACT (Pediatric Advanced Care Team), POGO (Pediatric Oncology Group of Ontario), and Brain Tumour Research at The Hospital for Sick Children, \$20,000 to the Dr. Jay Foundation Children's Grief Program and \$15,000 to the Panov Program in Precision Chemotherapy.
